Over the next few weeks we have various carol services, nativity plays, the singing of carols in care homes, the Wednesday Friendship Group, West Quay Shopping Centre, Costco, Ikea and the Guildhall! We also have Advent Family Prayer Time before school for the parents to join in on.

On top of all this our regular Celebration of the Word takes place on a Tuesday afternoon led by Mrs. Hales and Fr Ross. On a Wednesday morning a different year group attends and participates in our Wednesday morning Parish Mass in St Patrick's Church.

The lovely Dominican Sisters from Sway come in on a Wednesday afternoon to run the JCLUB aka Jesus Club, which is a very popular after school club which is catechetical in nature but fun at the same time.

We also have our Children's Mass once a month on a Sunday morning at St Patrick's Church, the main lead is taken by Mrs Hales and children from St Patrick's School.



On Thursday morning of this past week Fr Ross said an Advent Mass for the entire Year 9 cohort, always a joy to see some familiar faces, including former St Patrick's pupils. This coming Tuesday morning, Fr Ross will be at St George College to hear confessions. Many thanks to Mr Walford for coordinating these events. Then as usual on a Friday morning Fr Ross will continue his chaplaincy duties at St. George's.

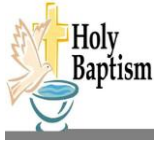
